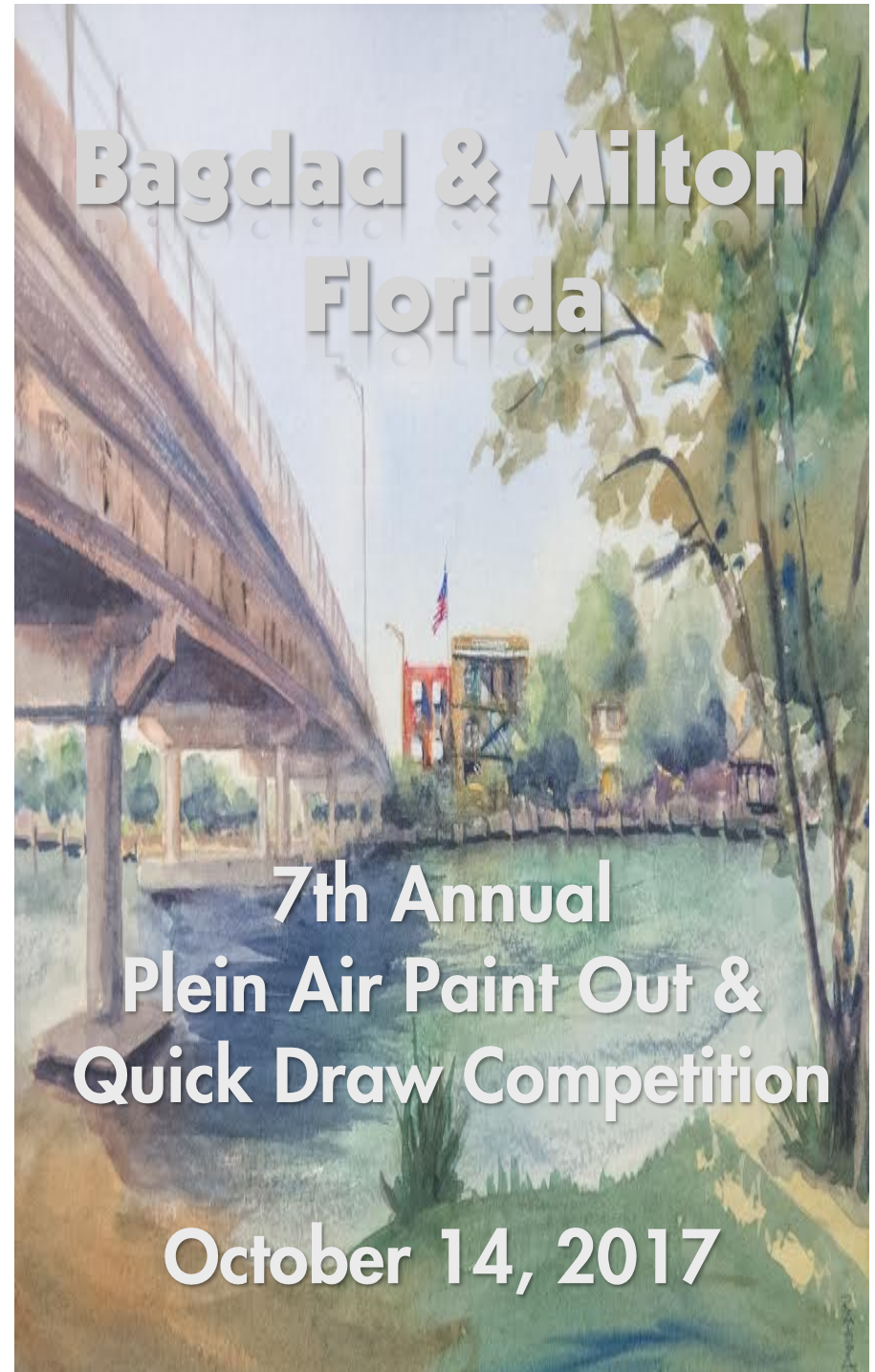

8:00am- 2:30pm Plein Air Paint Out
1:00pm- 2:30pm Paddle Paint Out Competition
3:00pm- Afternoon Luncheon and Judging

Registration Rules & Times

8:00 -8:30am

You must register and sign in at The Dragonfly Gallery & get your Canvas or Paddle stamped before you head out and create. Dragonfly Gallery is located at 6815 Caroline Street in Milton, FL. (**Maximum Canvas size is 16 X 20**) We will have Coffee and breakfast treats for the artists. At 2:30 pm all painting must stop. At that time artists may frame up to 2 pieces of work that they created on "Plein Air" that day. (Frames must be supplied by artists and have D-ring or screw eyes and wire for hanging.) Artists can paint anywhere in the outdoors of the Milton & Bagdad. (See the Map for "Plein Air" Hot Spots)

1:00pm-2:30pm

Paddle Paint Out Competition will begin & Plein Air Artist may choose to continue working til 2:30pm on morning canvases or join in the fun of painting a landscape on a canoe paddle.

All participants will begin to paint at the sound of the horn blast at 1:00.
Brushes go down at the 2:30pm at the sound of the horn.

2:30pm ~ "Plein Air" Competition Stops

2:30pm ~ "Paddle Paint Out " Competition Stops

3:00pm

All "Framed Work" and "Paddles" must be dropped off to the feature room at the Dragonfly Gallery where they will be hung an judged. No work will be accepted for judging after 3:00pm.

3:00pm

Artist luncheon will be served At the Women's Club House on Oak Street while show is being judged.

4:30 p.m.

The winners will be announced at Dragon Fly Gallery and prizes will be awarded.
Purchases can be made at reception or while the show is hanging.

October 14th -November 14th

During these Dates the "Plein Air" and "Paddle Paint Out" show will hang at the gallery.
After the initial hanging day a 20% commission fee will be charged by the gallery if your art work sells while on display at gallery.

A CALL TO ARTISTS:

This fall, the Santa Rosa Arts and Culture Foundation will be hosting the seventh Plein Air "Paint Out". On Saturday, October 14, 2016, from Bagdad to Milton you will find artists that have been invited to set up their canvas an easel to capture the scenery of these two historic towns. We encourage all painters and pastel artists to participate in the event.

Plein Air Painting is landscape painting that is done outside in the open air. This style became popular during the impressionist era when painting moved from the studio to the out of doors. It is characterized by less detail and the artist's desire to capture a fleeting moment. Given the need to work quickly and without repeated passes of the brush, plein air landscapes are typically spontaneous, fresh and bold in feeling and look.

You will find that the Village of Bagdad offers artist's scenic views of the Blackwater River, the Bay, historic homes/buildings an a canopy of huge Live Oak trees and Spanish moss. Historic Downtown Milton was built on the edge of the Blackwater River with breath taking scenes along the river walk area. Milton also, has many historic homes, churches, and parks. Both cities share the banks of Blackwater River which have some amazing scenic views. We know you will all love strolling out on a brisk October morning to pick your site, set up your canvas to paint, and capture all these amazing views.
